The Design

The theatre has been designed by Tim Ronald's Architects, an award winning practice specialising in theatre design and responsible for the renowned Hackney Empire Theatre.

The £1.4 million theatre will consist of a 290 seat auditorium with a mezzanine level. The space can be used in a

variety of configurations; end-on stage, cabaret, thrust, traverse and in the round. The theatre will have good state of the art technical facilities in sound, light and projection.

The light and airy foyer will overlook the picturesque Moreton landscape and will house a bar and café facilities.
